Vision for CR 2020

First, let's review some of the steps forward we took in 2019:

Part 1 – Highlights in 2019

- 1. We clarified our church's vision and came together as a staff and as a body to begin moving in the same direction.
- 2. We created better infrastructure for our church, which now includes each of the elders, so that our staff/people are being led and managed more effectively. As a result, we have seen overall improvement in most, if not all, areas of ministry.

3. We added key positions to our staff (some were a financial step of faith) to position ourselves for growth.

3. In partnership with United House, we were able to become a church that strategically helps people in need to have a second chance.

4. We were able to help build the kingdom by hosting 2 churches in our facility, at no cost to either of them, and we were an instrumental part of starting a church in Ghana.We plan to use our facility to help more congregations

start and function, as the Lord leads.

5. We started a "Safety Team" that provides us with protection if we are attacked.

6. We began to improve our facilities.
